Statement of Purpose: The Buckeye Parrot Head Club is a not-for-profit organization whose purpose is to assist with community and environmental concerns, and to provide a variety of social activities for people with similar tastes and interests. The Buckeye Parrot Head Club is chartered with the Parrot Heads in Paradise, the national organization that oversees all local Parrot Head Clubs.

Ticket Rules for the Buckeye Parrot Head Club

The following rules will be used to purchase tickets for Jimmy Buffett concerts through the Buckeye Parrot Head Club and Parrot Heads in Paradise, Inc. (PhiP). If there is a conflict between any Buckeye Parrot Head Club rule and the requirements set forth by PhiP, the PhiP rules shall take precedent.

1. Tickets for a show will be communicated to the general membership as soon as PhiP has notified the local ticket coordinator. This will be done by e-mail, the web site, the club hotline, and the newsletter if time permits.
2. The coordinator will make his/her best guess as to the cost of the ticket. The due date for all money, to be paid and cost will be communicated as soon as possible. Please note that there are occasions where clubs are given less than a week to get their requests in.
3. BPHC members will be required to make ticket requests and pay for the tickets by the date specified by the local ticket coordinator. If the money has not been paid, the tickets will not be ordered. **NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!!!**
4. In the event that members request more tickets than are allotted to the club, the point system spelled out in the bylaws will be used to determine who is eligible for tickets.
5. If the cost of the tickets are different than originally believed, the following policy will be used:
 - If the tickets cost more than originally paid, the member will be responsible for the difference when they pick up the tickets.
 - If the tickets cost less than originally paid, but the difference is less than \$5, the difference **WILL NOT** be refunded and will be donated to a charity of the club's choosing.
 - If the tickets cost less than originally paid and the difference is more than \$5, refunds will be issued rounded down to the nearest whole dollar.
6. Tickets can be picked up at any club event. If you request that tickets be mailed to you, they will be mailed at **YOUR** risk. The club will not take responsibility for tickets lost in the mail.

Raffle for Charitable Activities

We will be handing out raffle tickets at our annual Christmas party each year. For each charitable event you attend, you will receive one raffle ticket. At the Christmas party, there will be a raffle drawing for an item autographed by Jimmy Buffett.
